- 2. The local conference maximum will be equal to conference registration fee.
- 3. Applications are accepted throughout the year, with quarterly deadlines of March 31, June 30, September 30 and December 31.
- 4. Event Funds are considered seed monies, such that if the event provider makes a profit then CPEF provided funds will be returned to CPEF, up to a maximum of 100% of the funds provided.
- 5. Only one individual request will be granted in a two year period.
- 6. Individuals presenting at meetings will be given priority.
- 7. Events supporting interprofessional learning will be given priority.
- 8. Preference is given to events with broad access.
